Easter eggs are an important part of Easter as they represent new life and the beginning of spring. Christians also believe that the egg symbolises the empty tomb and Jesus rising again from the dead.



A tradition on Good Friday is to eat hot cross buns. They are a sweet bread and the top of the bun is decorated with a cross in remembrance of Jesus dying on the cross and then living again.



Christians receive palm crosses during a special Palm Sunday service. This is to help them remember how Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey and people laid palm leaves down on the ground for him to walk on.



The Easter Bunny is a very old tradition. Legend has it that the Easter Bunny leaves decorated eggs for children to find when they wake up on Easter morning.



Baby chicks and other baby animals are seen as a symbol of Easter. They are also a sign of new life. The chicks hatch from eggs, which are also a symbol of Easter.



Spring flowers are a sign of new life, the beginning of spring and are used as a symbol of Jesus' resurrection. They are used to decorate houses and churches at Easter.

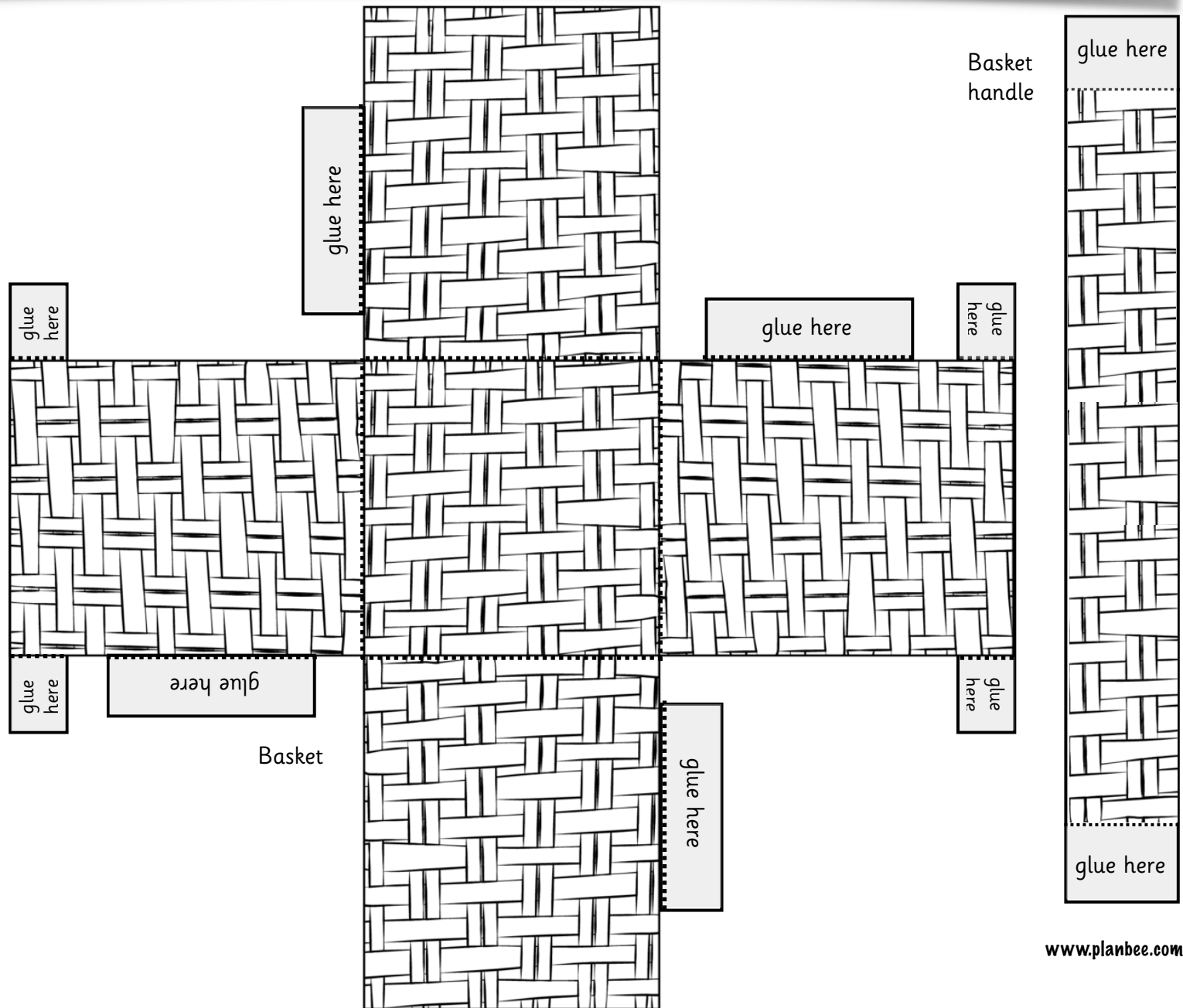
## Instructions:

Cut along the solid lines.

Once your basket shape is cut out you can decorate it as you wish.

Fold back the dotted lines and put a dab of glue on the grey boxes. Stick the grey tabs on the inside of the basket so you won't see them.

Finally stick the basket handle on the inside sides of your basket and your basket is ready for collecting eggs.





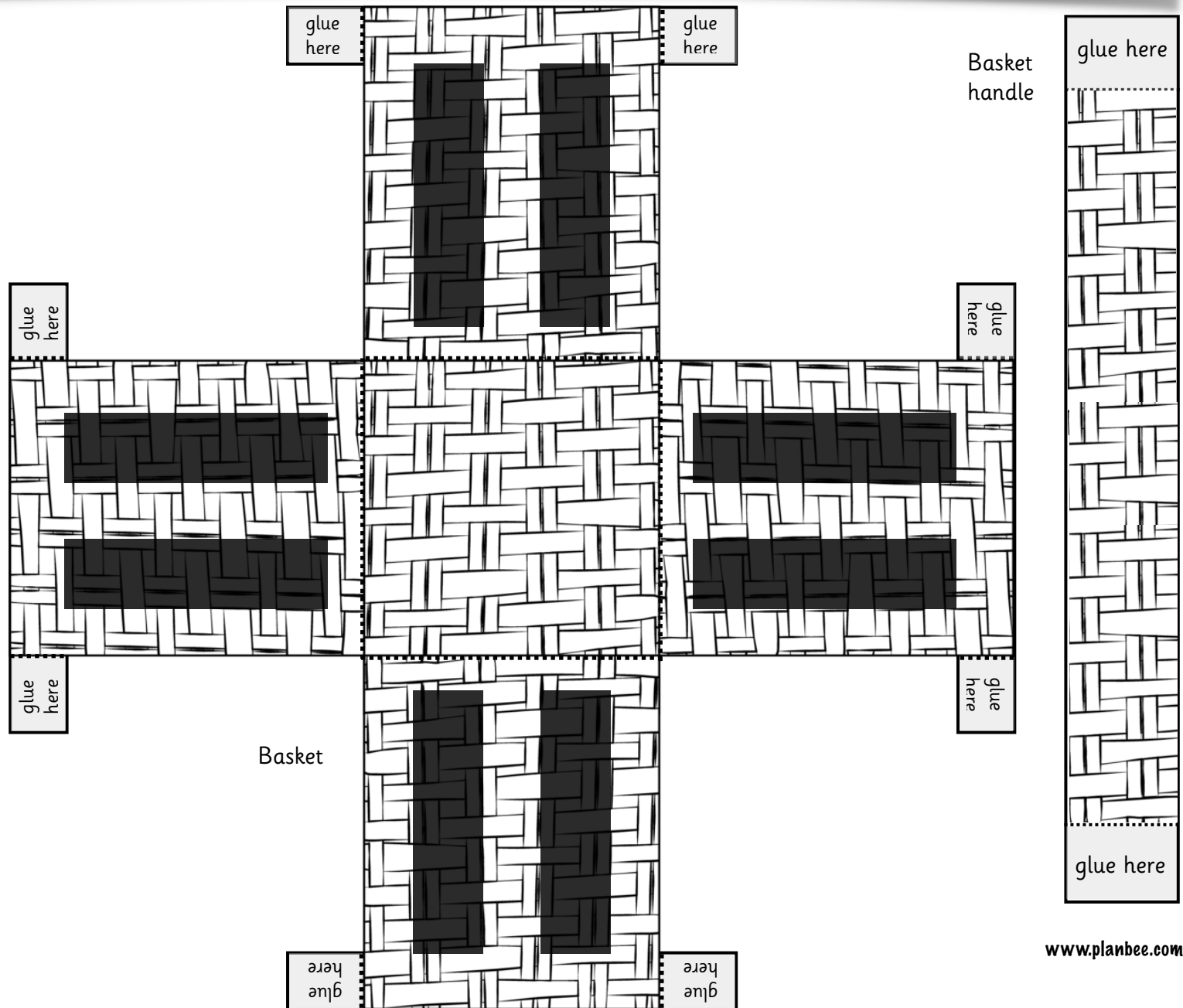
## Instructions:

Cut along the solid lines and fold back the dotted lines.

Cut out the solid black rectangles. You may need an adult's help to do this.

Once your basket shape is cut out, glue the grey boxes. Stick the grey tabs on the inside of the basket so you won't see them.

Cut out the strips of paper and weave them back and forth through the holes in the sides.
