- This was when Jesus was born. This is now known as Christmas.



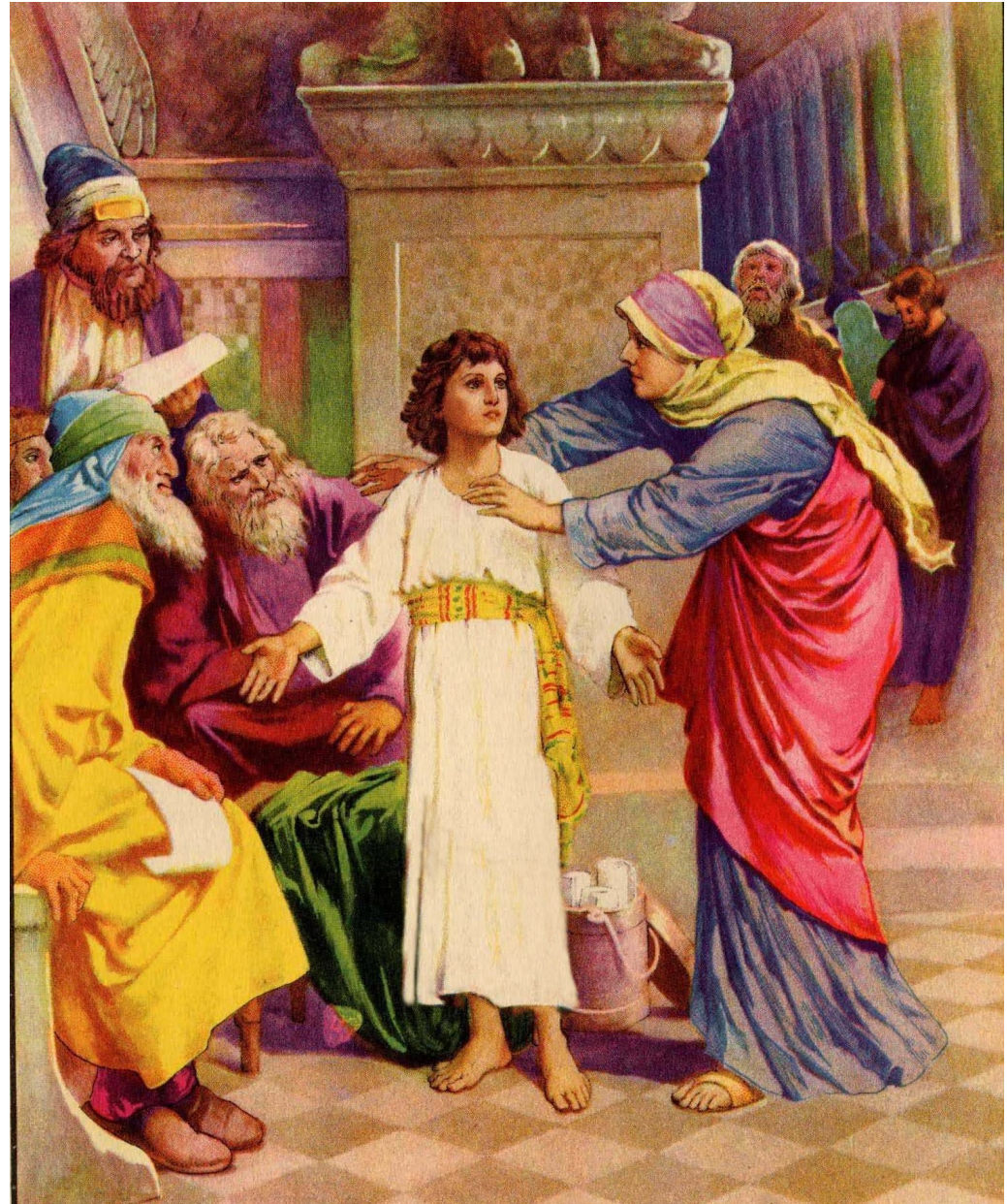
# The Presentation

# The Wedding at Cana

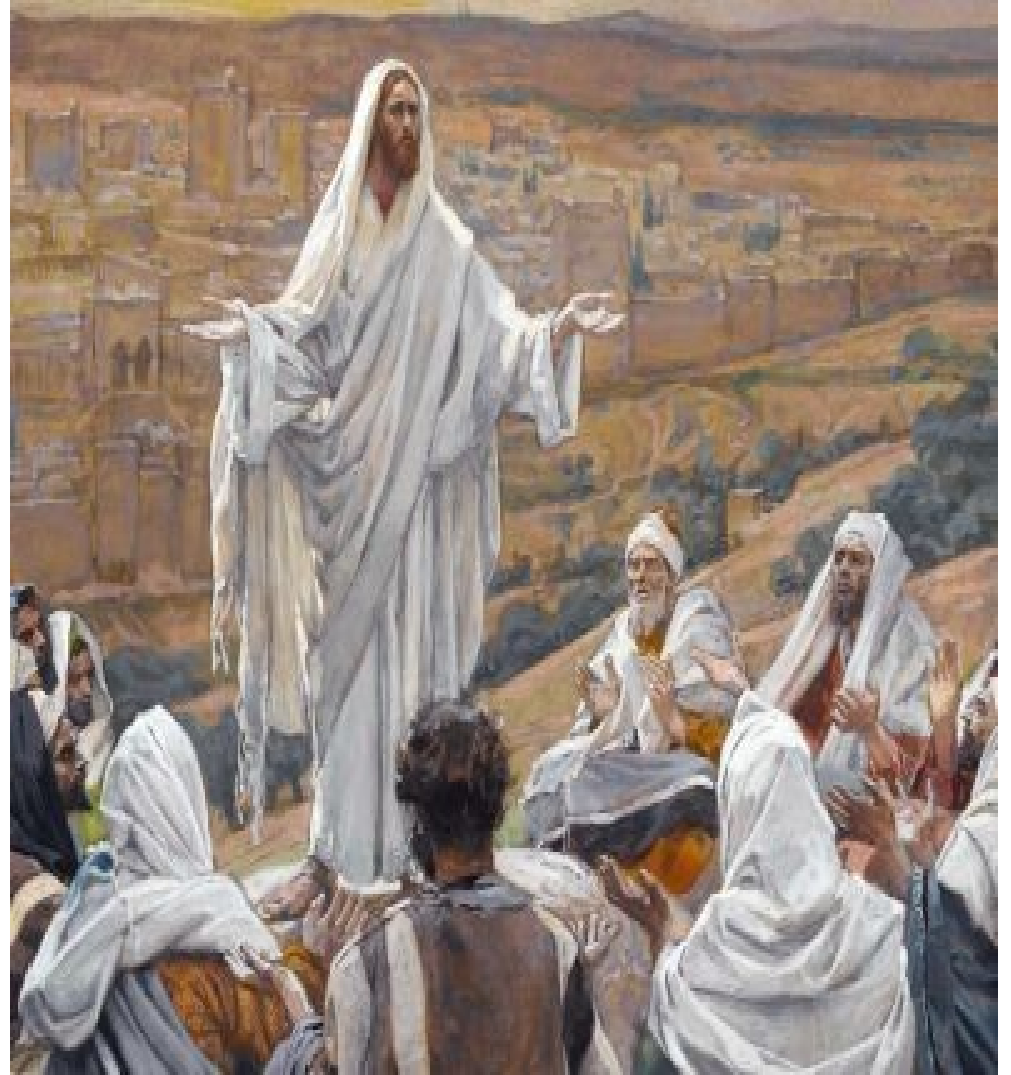
- Jesus performed his first miracle which was turning water into wine.

- This was the Last Supper.



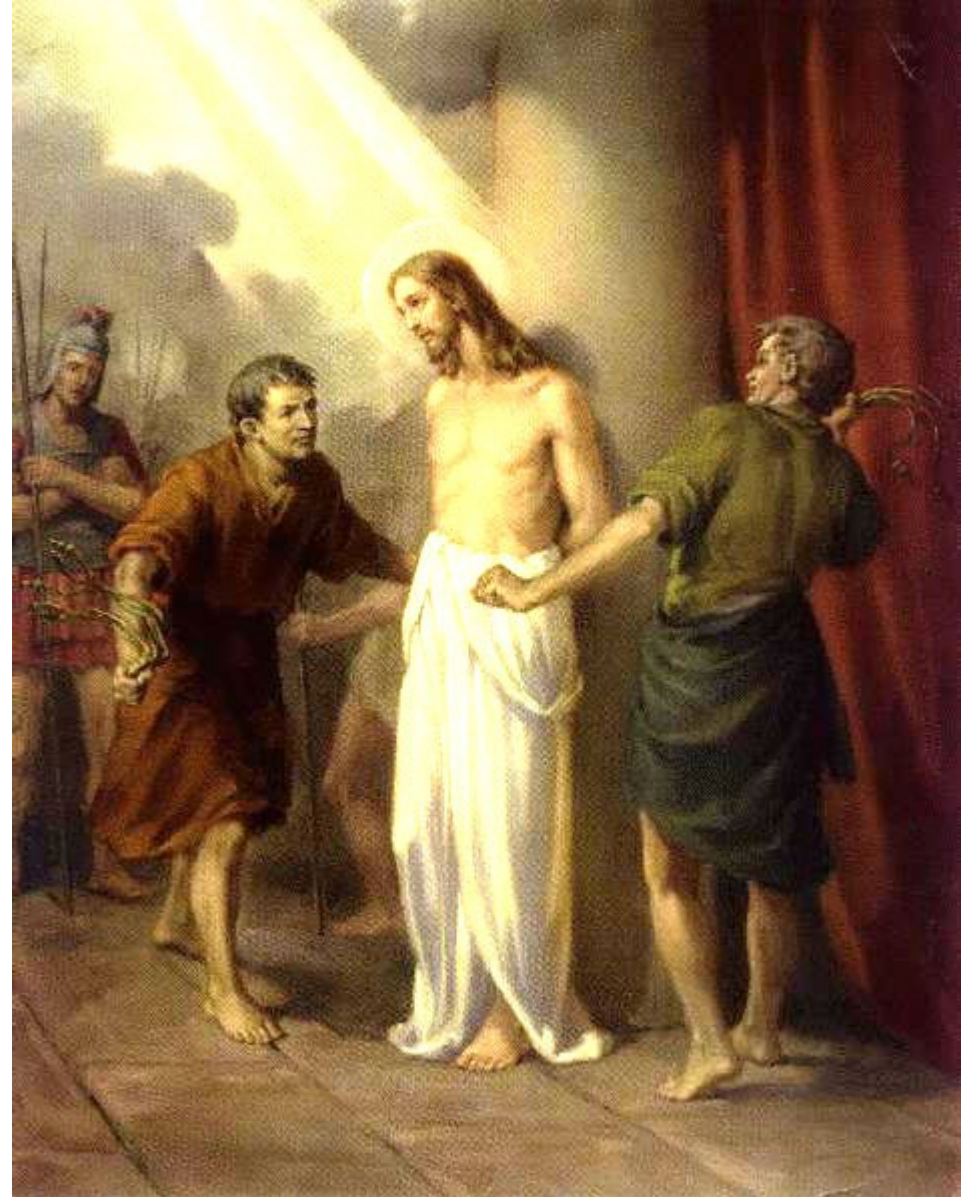
# The Agony in the Garden

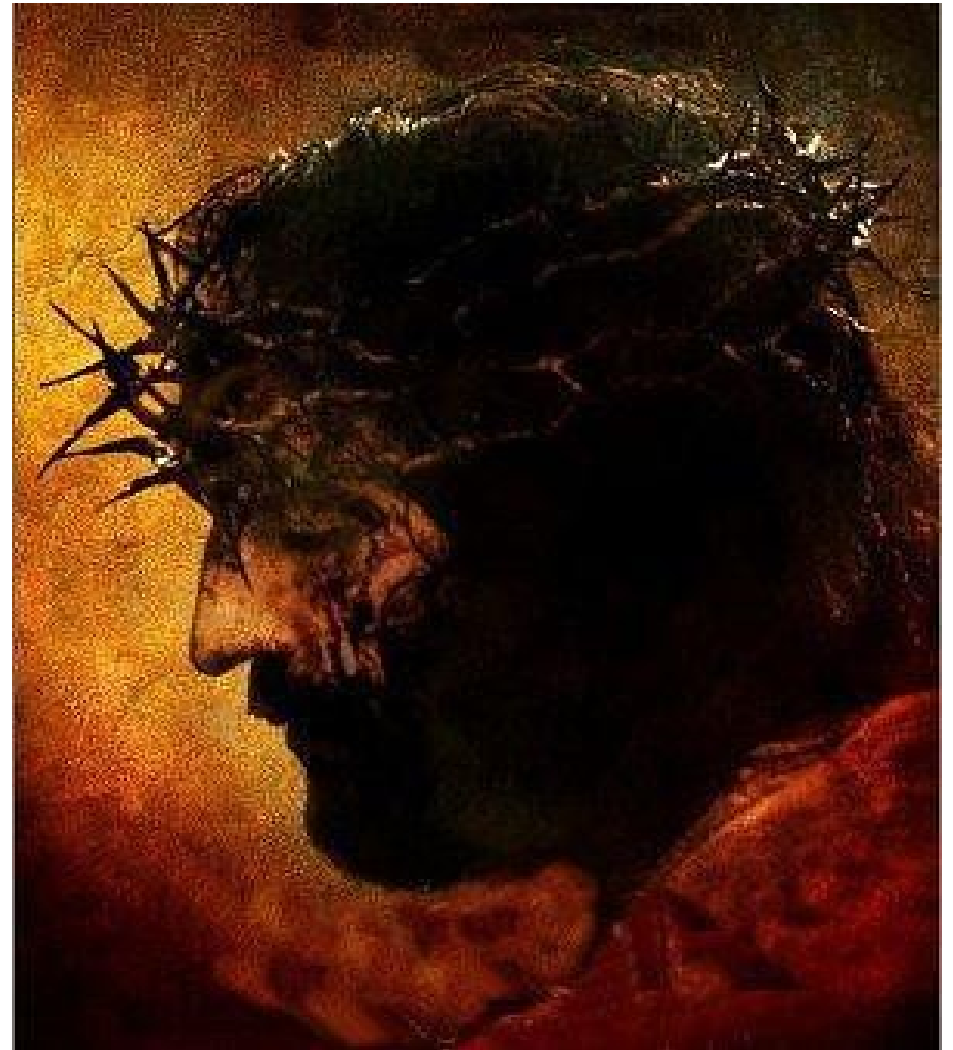
# The Scourging at the Pillar
