Look for pairs to 10!

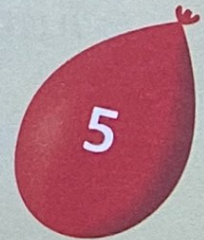

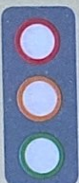
