#### Your task

- Type a conversation between the two men when they take the eagle out early in the morning.
- **Ch1** Use inverted commas at the beginning and end of speech as well as commas and full stops where needed. (e.g. "Where are you taking me?" said the farmer.)
- **Ch2** As above and avoid the use of 'said' (e.g. "Where are you taking me?" enquired the farmer).
- **Ch3** As above and using adverbs (e.g. "Where are you taking me?" groaned the man <u>impatiently</u>.)
