Week 9 Activities

This week we have some exciting activities for you to do at home and at school for those who have returned to school.

## Day 1

Refer to the word mat for key words.

Colour in one of the pictures on feeding the 5000.

Day 2

Recap the story of Jesus feeding the 5000 people. (Matthew 14:13-21)

Use the provided sheet to write sentences about the story. Use the word mat for key words.

Day 3

NEW TOPIC - FRIENDS.

Discuss with your child what friends are.

Talk about what friends do together. Is it always easy? What can go wrong?

Use the sheet provided to do a poster about what friends do together.

Children can label using the different activities eg Play together. Share toys etc.

## Day 4

Handa's Surprise: Learning about Africa.

Use the map provided or a globe if you have one to show the children the map of Africa. Talk about at least 3 different countries. Use the map to explain that African is a continent made up of different countries and that it is not a country.

Explain that there are different languages spoken in the different African countries and that there is no single language for the continent.

Cut out some of the fruit from Africa. If possible, and you can find some, let your child taste and describe the fruit.
