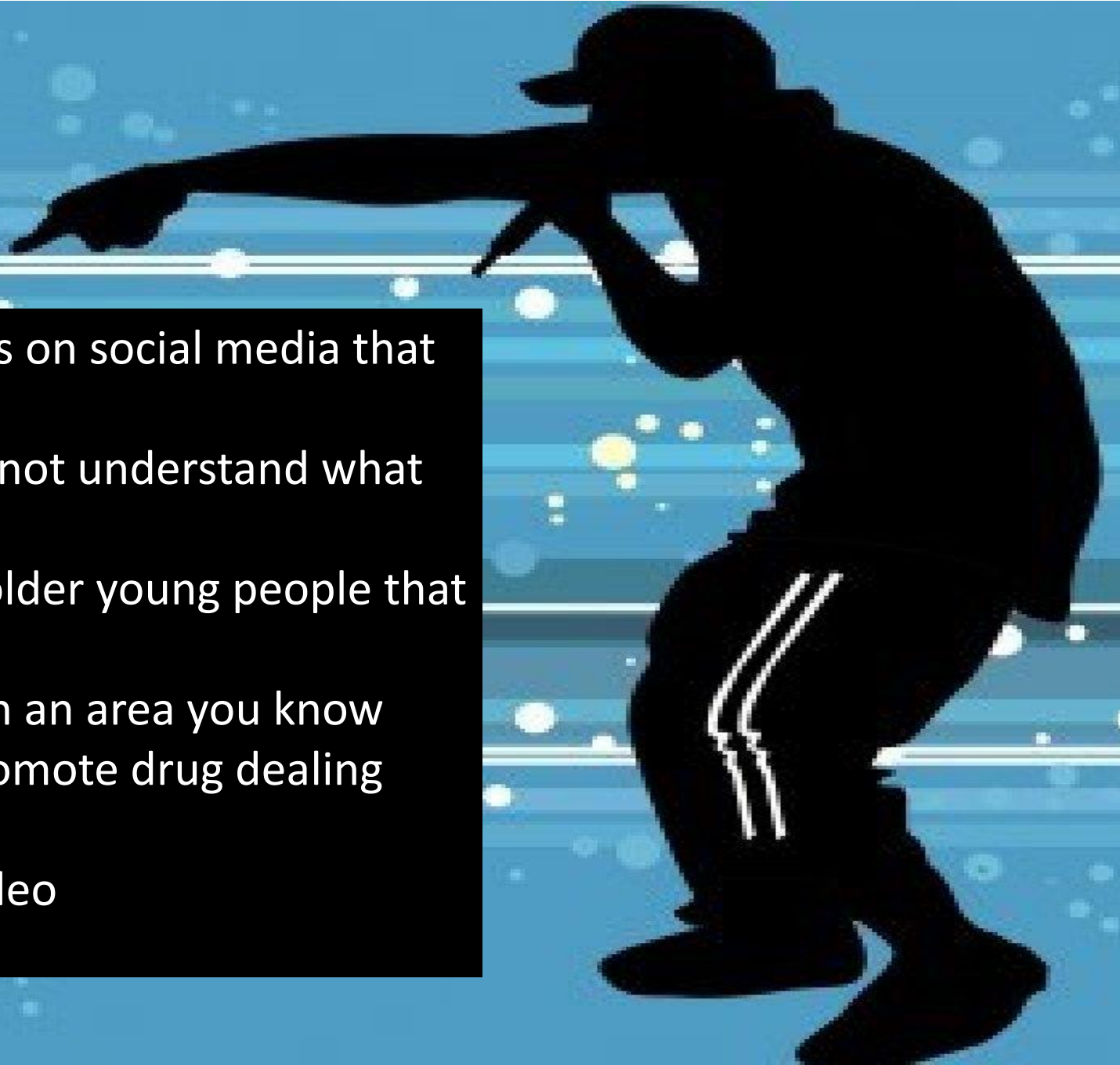


- You may be approached by a group of older boys or girls in the park or on your way home from school.

Nothing is free!



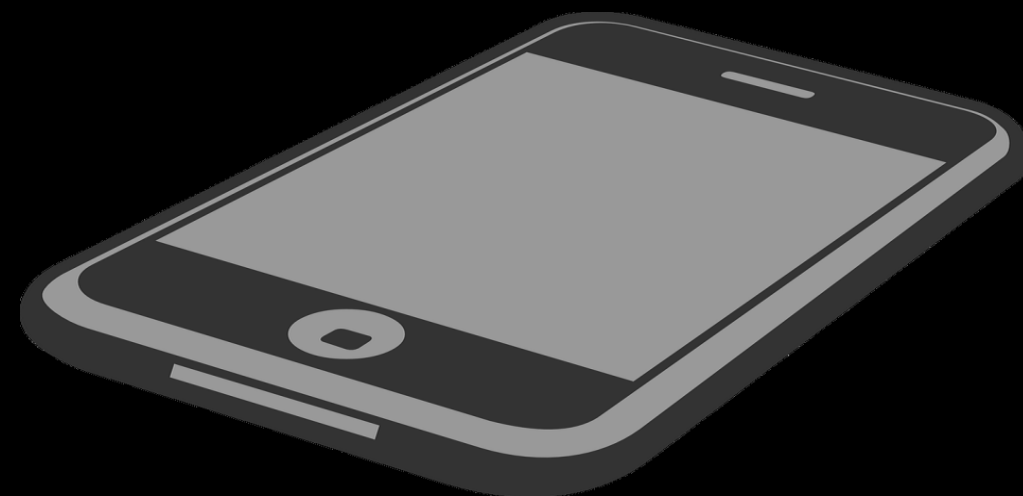
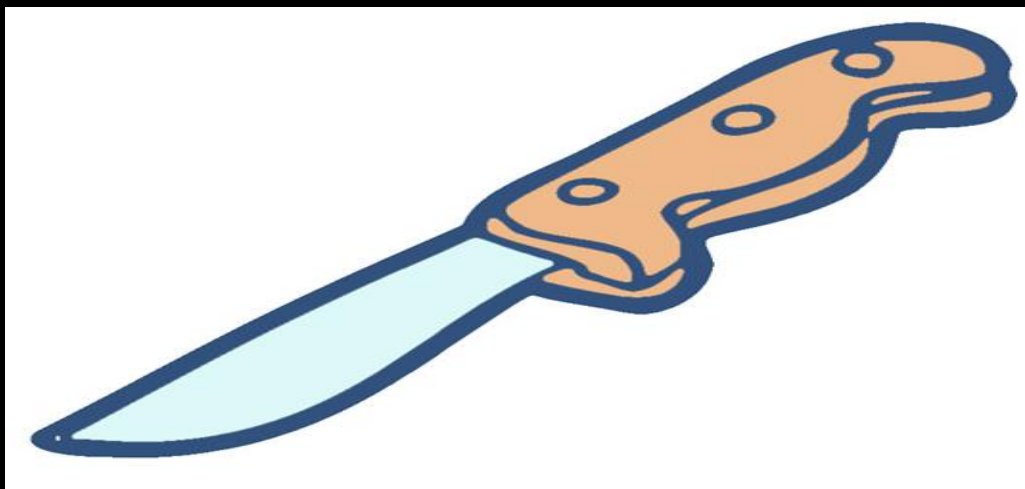
- You may see some music videos on social media that you like
